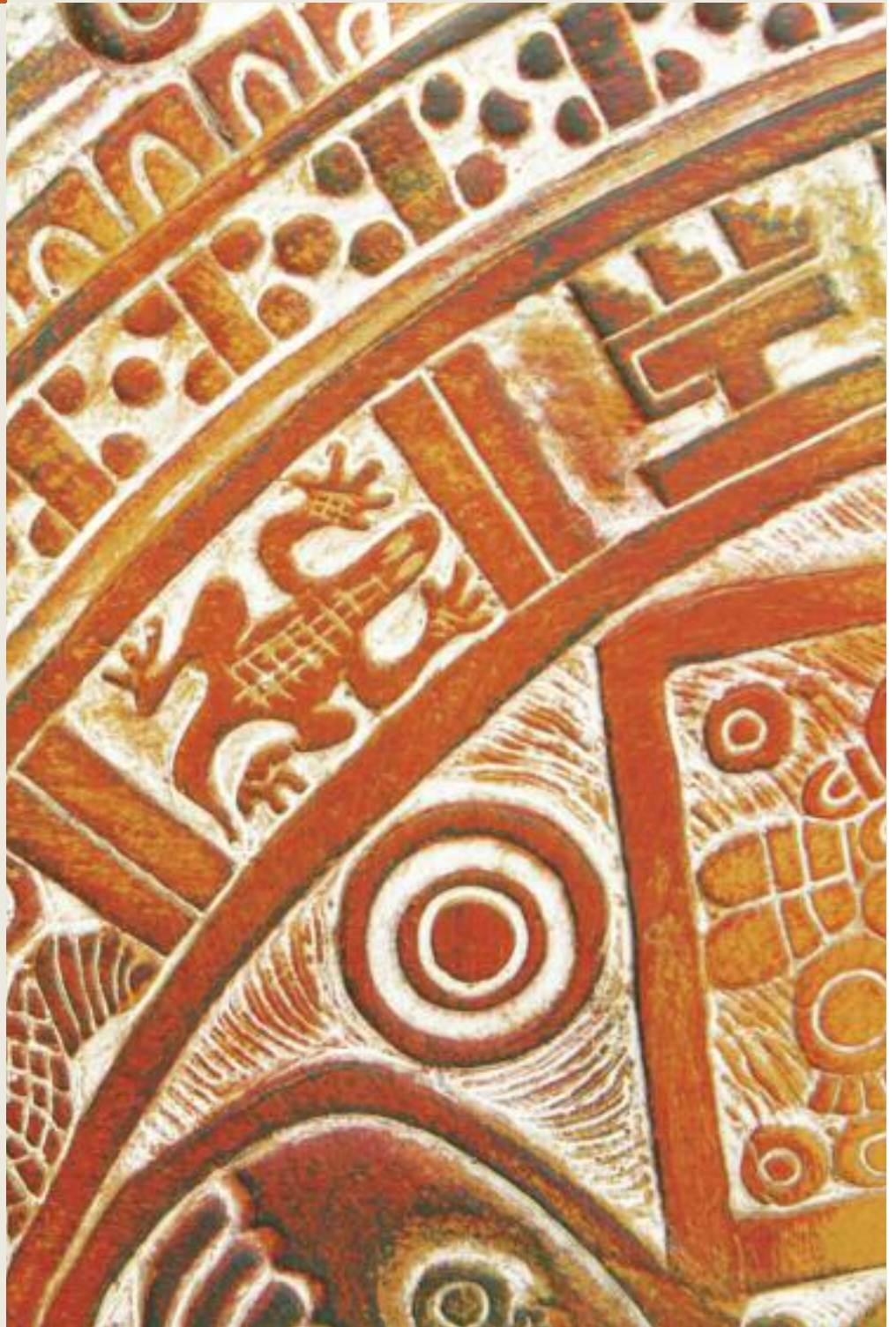

**AMERICAN ECONOMIC ASSOCIATION: BEST UNDERGRADUATE PAPER AWARD****International Atlantic Economic Society: Best Undergraduate Paper Competition**

To encourage undergraduate interest in economic issues, the International Atlantic Economic Society invites undergraduate students to compete in the IAES annual undergraduate paper competition. The winner of the student competition will receive: a \$500 check, a handsome commemorative plaque, and complimentary publication of the paper in the Atlantic Economic Journal. The winner will be selected at the International Atlantic Economic Conference annual conference in October.

The submission deadline is July 1.

**Midwest Economics Association Undergraduate Sessions**

The Midwest Economics Association invites undergraduates to present their essays at special undergraduate sessions of the annual meeting each March. An award of \$200 goes to the best undergraduate essay. The deadline for submission of the essay is November 15.

**American Nuclear Society Undergraduate Scholarships**

Undergraduate scholarships will be awarded as follows: a maximum of four scholarships for students who have completed one year in a course of study leading to a degree in nuclear science, nuclear engineering, or a nuclear-related field and who will be sophomores in the upcoming academic year; and a maximum of 21 scholarships for students who have completed two or more years and will be entering as juniors or seniors.

ANS also awards the following individual undergraduate scholarships for students who have completed two or more years in a course of study leading to a degree in nuclear science, nuclear engineering, or a nuclear-related field.

Through its scholarship committee, The Ebell continues to seek out and subsidize academically outstanding students awarding grants totaling over \$200,000 annually.

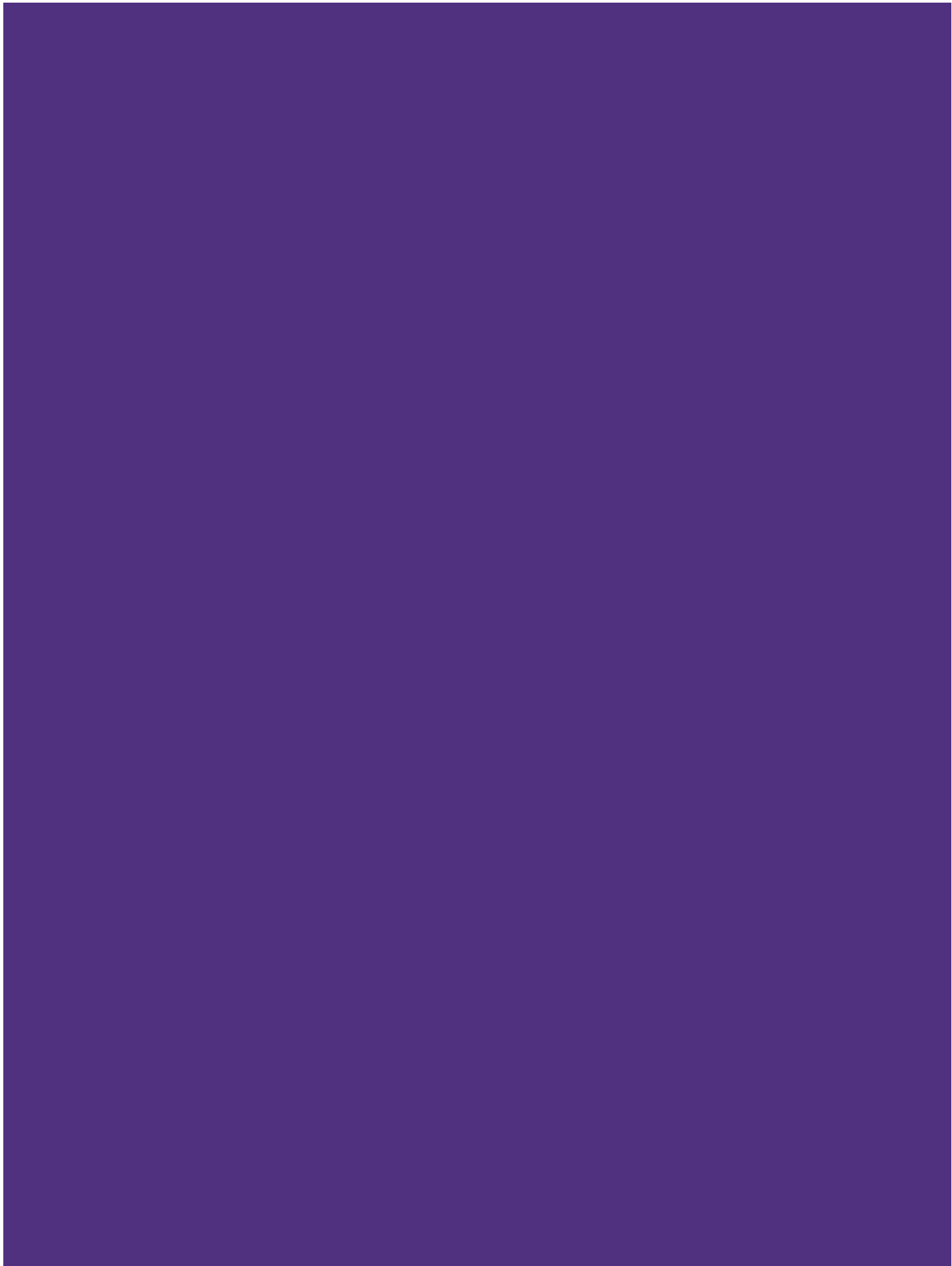

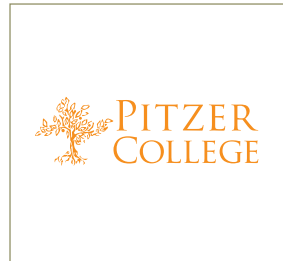
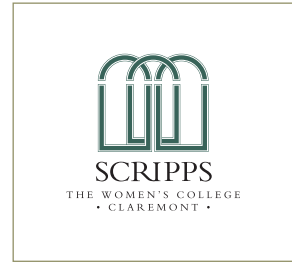
