We aim to provide students with the knowledge, resources, and support they need to make informed decisions about their health and well-being, ultimately empowering them to lead balanced and healthy lives during their college years and beyond.

HEO Services

- Provides safe sex supplies (variety of condoms and lube, finger cots, and dental dams),
- Provides 100% organic cotton and gynecologist-approved menstrual health products.
- Provides a variety of health and wellness literature/zine collection for student's collection.
- Along with connecting students to in-house campus resources, we also connect students to outside resources that will support the student's needs such as local planned parenthood or health clinics.
- Supplies dental hygiene products and provides education on maintaining proper oral care.
- Administers Narcan and offers in-depth, peer-to-peer training on overdose prevention and response.
- Provides rapid COVID-19 testing for students, ensuring timely results and peace of mind.
