The following is a brief description of the Travel Insurance Plan. The benefits described are subject to certain limitations and exclusions as described in the certificate of insurance. ## Eligibility

**Class I:** All students of the policyholder while traveling outside of their home country and participating in a school-approved trip, including 15-day personal deviation immediately prior to or after said trip.

**Class II:** All faculty and guests of the policyholder while traveling outside of their home country and participating in a school-approved trip, including 15-day personal deviation immediately prior to or after said program.
