

Plumbing Shop

The Plumbing Shop manages the campus water systems, including maintaining and repairing main water lines, reclaimed water systems, and backflow prevention equipment. The team supports outside contractors with hookups to water, gas, or sewer lines and ensures underground work does not interfere with existing infrastructure. Their responsibilities include plumbing installation, fixture repairs, gas line maintenance, water pressure checks, and responding to issues such as leaking faucets, clogged toilets, and sewer lines.

Services

The Plumbing and Heating Shop provides a comprehensive range of services, including:

- ◆ Installation and maintenance of hydronic and steam boilers.
- ◆ Unclogging and snaking drains, main lines, and branches.
- ◆ Installing various plumbing lines, including copper, cast iron, and PVC.
- ◆ Testing and repairing backflow preventers, ensuring compliance with county and water company regulations.
- ◆ Installing, repairing, and maintaining boilers and sump pumps.
- ◆ Asbestos testing for building materials, such as plaster, fireproofing, mastics, insulation, and roofing.
- ◆ Monitoring and testing chemicals in closed-loop heating systems.
- ◆ Monitoring and maintaining soft water systems.
- ◆ Preventive maintenance on sanitary drains, water heater filters, and boilers.
