The Campus Safety Department, **operating 24/7 year-round**, maintains a variety of emergency medical programs, resources, supplies, and equipment to assist anyone who becomes injured, experiences an adverse reaction to a substance, or is affected by illness. These resources include:

Automated External Defibrillator (AED) – Patrol officers are certified to use and carry an AED unit and have access to dozens of AEDs located throughout the colleges and TCCS facilities. These devices can be used in any situation where a person is experiencing cardiac arrest or a cardiac emergency.

First Aid / CPR – All Campus Safety Officers are trained and certified to perform a wide variety of emergency medical response procedures.

Naloxone – All Campus Safety Officers carry NARCAN (Naloxone) to aid in the response and life-saving effort for anyone who is reported to be incapacitated due to opioid use. All officers are trained and certified by the Los Angeles County Department of Health to assess patients and administer NARCAN when necessary.

Stop the Bleed – This fully certified program trains and equips our officers with life-saving techniques to respond to critical open wounds, including those involving severe blood loss.

In addition to these response capabilities during a medical emergency, the Campus Safety Department collaborates with the Los Angeles County Fire Department, including local fire stations and paramedic teams, coordinating first responders, ambulances, and other emergency transportation services.
